
COMPETITIONS FOR 2010

To all Team Officials

Welcome to the netball season for 2010 and we expect to have another great year for all our netballers, coaches, umpires and parents.

This year the Monday Night competitions will consist of two 15 week competitions. For both Juniors/Seniors in the winter competition this will be preceded by 3 weeks of grading.

Nova teams will play non-competitive rounds in conjunction with the junior competition. Note that for 2010 we will open up to 6 year old players. Pending uptake and team nominations, a decision will be made in relation to either competition or skills program for this age group.

Times for all age groups will be notified as soon as team nominations are collated.

CLUBS ARE ASKED TO GRADE THEIR OWN TEAMS BEFORE HDNA SIGN ON DAY.

It's important that Clubs Grade their players then nominate the teams according to the standard of play for the relevant Division, not the Grading within the club. E.g. HDNA 13 Years Divisions 1, 2, 3 not Rangers 13 A, B, C.

Please note there are generally NO games played during school holidays or on State Events for Nova & Juniors. Cadets/Seniors/Mixed will play on school holidays. Please refer to our HDNA Calendar of Events for details.

FEES

All clubs/individual teams are required to be members of (or affiliated with) HDNA in order to play in our competitions. This requires completion of the Affiliation form (located in this pack on page 13) and payment of the fee to join any HDNA competition in 2010. Please note that the details contained on the form, once registered, provide confirmation of accepted and registered uniform for the team/club, and also provides us with contact details to notify events to our members. Should the contact or address details change, please notify the Executive HDNA as soon as possible.

Affiliation must be paid when the club/team nominate on HDNA sign on days.

Two levels of membership are available:

1. Full Membership - \$20-00 Full Member clubs **must attend** all Delegates &/or General Meetings set down as per our calendar and are entitled to one vote.
2. Social Membership - \$10-00 Social Member clubs/teams are welcome to attend but not entitled to vote at Delegate &/or General Meetings.

Please check club records as only ONE affiliation is required for clubs with Nova, Junior, Senior, and/or Mixed teams

Player Fees (A small increase for 2010 due to Netball Qld raising their fees)

\$105-00 per player for Winter competition within HDNA

\$60-00 per player if already registered with another NQ association within the calendar year. Proof of receipt is required.

\$50-00 per player for second competition within HDNA

All players' fees should be paid to your club/team representative who will then forward payment to the Association together with completed paperwork.

Grading for Novas & Juniors

This season teams will be graded according to the following:

Note - Boys up to 12 years (born between 2004 & 1998) are also eligible to play.

Novas

6 years - born 2004, 7 years born 2003, 8 years - born 2002, 9 years born 2001 & 10 years born 2000

Juniors

11 years - born 1999, 12 years born 1998, 13 years born 1997, 14 years born 1996
15 years born 1995, 16 years born 1994 & 17 years born 1993.

Clubs should grade their teams according to age and ability prior to HDNA sign on, then nominate them in a suitable division e.g. 1,2,3 within the above groups.

Umpiring for Monday Night Competition

The HDNA Umpires Co-ordinator will allocate umpires to the games. Each team is to pay \$14 per week for the umpires; a bag will be attached to the scoreboard for the fees to be paid into. You are most welcome to pay the fees for the whole season in advance. A forfeit fee of \$40 will be charged if 24 hours notice prior to the Monday night games is not given. UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Each Club/Independent team must register their club/team colours and uniform with the Association at the commencement of each year. New colours and changes of colours must be approved before purchase of new uniforms. This is to ensure no two club/teams are the same, for recognition of your club/team and assistance to umpires.

Uniforms must all be identical in colour & style. Skirts/ shorts must all be the same and shirts must be the same style and colour.

For **mixed teams only** females may wear shorts but if this is the chosen option then **all** female players in your team must wear shorts.

Socks **must** be worn. Sports briefs must be worn, bike pants may be worn **but must not show beneath the skirt.** Both socks and briefs must be the colour indicated on the club affiliation form.

Nails should be cut short; taping of nails is not permitted, approved netball gloves are permitted under HDNA association rules. All jewellery should be left at home. Earrings, studs & sleepers & all body piercings **MUST be removed, not taped with the exception being a flat wedding ring.**

Correct uniform including sports briefs and socks must be worn each week by each team member.

If a player is out of uniform the Umpire has the right to exclude that player from the game

UMPIRING FOR SATURDAY JUNIOR COMPETITION

Following are the guidelines we will be using to ensure that umpiring is consistent, competent and equally shared amongst all teams during the Saturday Junior competition this season.

UMPIRING DUTY

1. Every team is required to supply a competent umpire, appropriately dressed (white skirt & white shirt), and equipped for umpiring duty every Saturday.
2. It is the responsibility of each team to ensure their umpires are competent. They do not require formal qualifications, but please ensure they have umpired before, are fully conversant with the rules of the game can handle themselves confidently.
3. Please ensure every umpire signs in the appropriate place in the umpire's book. Please sign this book at least 10 minutes before your duty game.
4. Umpire Duty is included in the Competition draw. If you do not supply an umpire for your duty game, the assigned team will lose points.
5. It is suggested that if any team is unable to have a competent umpire, that they pay someone to do this duty. It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that this duty is covered each week. Umpire Liaison Officers should liaise with other club contacts should they be unable to secure an umpire from within the club.
6. HDNA is not responsible for finding or placing suitable umpires on games other than finals.

DURING GRADING you will umpire your own matches.

Once the competition begins, each game will be allocated teams responsible to undertake umpiring commitments.

UMPIRES LIASION OFFICER For Saturday Competition only

1. Each club (or independent team) must nominate an Umpire's Liaison Officer. This person is responsible for the flow of information between the club and the umpire's convenor.
2. If a club has any concerns or problems to do with umpiring, they should contact their Umpire's Liaison Officer who will then liaise with other club contacts or discuss the issue with the Convenor. There may also be occasional brief meetings that the Liaison person will be asked to attend through the season. These will be held either just before or just after competition on Saturday's to minimize travel time etc.
3. Please advise the HDNA Umpires Convenor of the name of your Umpire's Liaison Officer, their telephone number and any other contact details.

GENERAL BEHAVIOUR

Our Association this year will have a large number of junior umpires, plus some senior umpires with limited experience. I ask that these people be given the full support of every club member, every parent and every spectator, particularly in situations where umpires display an 'in training' shirt or bib.

Umpiring is a tough, often thankless task. But without this vital role, we would have no games for our children to participate in and enjoy. Even just a simple "THANK YOU or WELL DONE" after the game can do much to boost an umpire's confidence and encourage them to stay involved for another season.
